1. Relationship with Taieri Indoor Bowling Club

REGULATIONS
of
TAIERI BOWLING CLUB
(Incorporated)

1. INTERPRETATION:

- 1.1 The words and phrases used in these Regulations shall have the same meaning as defined in the Constitution of the Club unless otherwise specified in these Regulations
- 1.2 The Schedules of these Regulations shall not form parts of these Regulations for the purposes of interpretation or amendment.

2. COMMENCEMENT DATE:

- 2.1 Under this Constitution, The Executive has determined that these Regulations shall come into force on 19 June 2011.
- 2.2 The Executive has also determined that all previous by-laws, regulations, rules or policies of the Club are revoked with effect from the commencement of these Regulations and from that date shall have no force or effect.

3. MEMBERS OF ASSOCIATED CLUB:

- 3.1 **Taieri Indoor Bowling Club:** Members of the Taieri Indoor Bowling Club shall be bound by the Laws of the Game for the time being provided by the New Zealand Indoor Bowls Association and shall be entitled to participate in the social and pavilion activities of the Club. (See Schedule 1)

4. GREENS:

The Executive shall appoint a Greens Convener who shall be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the greens and surrounds, supervise and, at each Executive meeting report on the state of the greens and such other matters as deemed desirable or as may be required by the Executive.

6. INTER-CLUB AND CENTRE COMPETITIONS:

The Executive shall decide what Inter-club and Centre matches and competitions shall be entered for by the Club during the ensuing season.

7. SELECTOR(S):

A Selector or Selectors (male and female) shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting. The duties of the Selector(s) shall be to select the Teams for all Inter-Club matches, to classify and handicap Players for Competitions, and to make

nominations in accordance with the constitution of the Centre for Representative Teams.

8. CLUB CAPTAIN

Two Club Captains (one male and one female) shall be elected at the annual meeting. The duties of the Club Captains shall be defined by the Executive.

9. SOCIAL MEMBERS

Financial Social Playing Members shall be entitled to participate in the social and pavilion activities of the Club and to play on the Club's greens on such days as the Executive approves, but shall not be eligible to play in Club trophy matches or to represent or play for the Club in any outside competition.

10. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Any financial Playing Member, Non Playing Member or Life Member of any other club affiliated to the Centre shall be eligible for election as an Associate Member. An Associate member shall be entitled to participate in the social and pavilion activities of the Club and to play on the Club's greens on such days as the Executive approves but shall not be eligible to play in Club trophy matches or to represent or play for the Club in any outside competitions.

11. STUDENT MEMBERS

Financial Student Members shall have all the rights of full playing members. The age limit for Student Membership shall be 25 years

SCHEDULE TO THE REGULATIONS

RELATIONSHIP WITH THE TAIERI INDOOR BOWLING CLUB

1. The Club is formed with the agreement and under the auspices of the Taieri Bowling Club Incorporated and shall be known as the Taieri Indoor Bowling Club.

2. Objects:

2.1 To promote the playing and practice of the game of Indoor Bowls (on mats) and to encourage healthy and rational recreation on behalf of the members of the Taieri Bowling Club Inc. and others who qualify for membership, during the months of April to October each year.

2.2 To promote, organise, regulate, hold and conduct tournaments, competitions, matches, games and other events, and to give, provide and contribute towards trophies and awards therefore.

- 2.3 To conduct such social activities as the management committee may from time to time organise or approve.

3. Membership:

- 3.1 The membership shall be unisex.
- 3.2 Financial members of the Taieri Bowling Club Inc. shall be entitled as of right to membership upon payment of the annual subscription in force at the time.
- 3.3 The management committee shall have authority to close the membership only after discussion with and the agreement of the Executive of the Taieri Bowling Club Inc.

4. Management:

- 4.1 The management of the Club shall be vested in a committee of management appointed by a General Meeting of the Indoor Club at the conclusion of the season.
- 4.2 The management committee shall consist of a President, Vice-president, Secretary, Treasurer, Club Captain and such number of other elected members as the Club shall consider necessary to operate the affairs of the Club.

5. Assets:

Subject to payment of affiliation fees and other dues to the New Zealand Indoor Bowls Association Inc., all assets of the Taieri Indoor Bowling Club shall automatically accrue to the benefit of the Taieri Bowling Club Inc.

6. Subscriptions and Fees:

All subscriptions and fees payable by members shall be as determined by the management committee each year in consultation with the Bowls Taieri Inc.

7. Playing Rules:

Playing rules of the Club shall be in accordance with the Rules of the New Zealand Indoor Bowls Association Inc.

8. General:

The management committee shall be charged to act on behalf of its membership to:
Reach agreement with the Executive of the Taieri Bowling Club Inc. on conditions for use of the premises;
Initiate and action any matters of discipline where any breach of acceptable general conduct has been noted or reported.
